Key Destinations



Lotus Temple

A stunning lotus-shaped Bahá'í House of Worship set amidst lush lawns, open to all religions for prayer and meditation.



Qutub Minar

★ UNESCO World Heritage Site

The world's tallest brick minaret at 73 metres, built in the early 13th century amid historic ruins.



Humayun's Tomb

★ UNESCO World Heritage Site

A fine Mughal garden tomb that inspired the Taj Mahal, built in red sandstone with double-domed architecture.



India Gate

A majestic 42-metre-high war memorial arch honouring Indian soldiers, flanked by manicured lawns.



Jama Masjid

A 17th-century grand mosque built by Emperor Shah Jahan in red sandstone and white marble.



Red Fort

★ UNESCO World Heritage Site

A massive 17th-century Mughal fortress in Old Delhi, famed for its ramparts and royal halls.



Swaminarayan Akshardham

A grand Hindu temple complex showcasing traditional Indian art, stone carvings, exhibitions, and musical fountain shows.

Tour Itinerary — Greater Noida ⇄ Delhi Darshan

TIME	ACTIVITY / LOCATION	DETAILS
07:00 AM	DEPARTURE TO DELHI	Pick up from Gautam Buddha University, Greater Noida. Drive approx. 45 km / 1 hr to Delhi.
08:15 AM	LOTUS TEMPLE	Visit the iconic lotus-shaped Bahá'í House of Worship for prayer and peaceful meditation.
09:30 AM	QUTUB MINAR	Explore the world's tallest brick minaret (73m) and the surrounding historic Qutub complex.
11:00 AM	HUMAYUN'S TOMB	Discover the grand Mughal garden tomb that inspired the architectural design of the Taj Mahal.
12:30 PM	INDIA GATE	Visit the landmark 42-metre war memorial dedicated to Indian soldiers, surrounded by open lawns.
01:15 PM	JAMA MASJID	Visit one of India's largest mosques, built by Emperor Shah Jahan in Old Delhi.
02:00 PM	LUNCH BREAK	Savour authentic Mughlai cuisine at a popular local restaurant in Old Delhi (e.g. Karim's or similar).
03:00 PM	RED FORT	Explore the magnificent 17th-century red sandstone fortress built by Emperor Shah Jahan.
05:00 PM	AKSHARDHAM TEMPLE	Explore the grand temple complex featuring intricate stone carvings, gardens, and optional evening Sahaj Anand Fountain Show.
07:15 PM	RETURN JOURNEY	Begin return drive back to Greater Noida (approx. 45 km / 1 hr).
08:15 PM	ARRIVE IN GREATER NOIDA	Drop at Gautam Buddha University, Greater Noida. Tour ends with unforgettable memories.
